EcoHost

Responsibilities:

- Greet and log daily EcoCenter guests
- Answer incoming calls
- Help with Gift Shop operations – sales, display, inventory
- Occasional help with event setup or breakdown
- Lead Green Building Tours



Time Commitment:

- The EcoCenter is open Thursday-Friday 11:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. and Saturday 10:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. in the winter. Open days/hours are extended during the summer. There are 2 EcoHost shifts per day – generally 2-3 hours in length
- We prefer EcoHosts to cover at least two shifts per month.

Training:

- EcoHost trainings will be held quarterly and will last approximately 1-2 hours.
- Additional trainings will be offered throughout the year to provide you with new and updated information.

Requirements and Experience Necessary:

- No experience necessary! You will be provided with all the training you need.
- No criminal record. Background checks will be completed and references will be checked.
- Must be 16 years or older.
