

VOLUNTEER POSITIONS AT SWANER PRESERVE AND ECOCENTER

Stream Restoration

Help improve water quality and wildlife habitat.

Responsibilities:

- Assist with cutting and collection of plant material for stream restoration projects.
- Assist with planting of native willows.
- Assist with installing conifer revetments, support for degraded streambanks, along East Canyon Creek.



Time Commitment:

- Each of these projects takes place in a 3 – 4 day block, with work taking place during a 3 – 4 hour shift each day.
- We prefer you commit to working the entire 3 – 4 hour shift on the day you've signed up for.
- The willow harvest takes place in late March – early April. Willow planting takes place in mid – late April. Streambank revetment installation takes place in late summer to early fall. These dates are dependant upon stream levels and weather trends.

Training:

- Training for these projects takes place during the first half hour of each shift. No advance training is necessary.

Requirements and Experience Necessary:

- No experience necessary! You will be provided with all the training you need.
- You must be active and comfortable moving around in the out of doors. Some jobs will involve strenuous work while others do not.
- You must be 14 years of age to participate in Willow Planting or Streambank Revetments.
