

# 4-H VOLUNTEER POSITIONS AT SWANER PRESERVE AND ECOCENTER

## Summer Camp Educator

### Responsibilities:

- Assist with or lead Summer Camp programs
  - 2-3 day or week-long day camps for youth in grades 1-8
  - Camps will include both indoor and outdoor activities
- Help with camp set-up and clean-up

### Time Commitment:

- Summer camps run June-August
- The summer camp schedule for 2012 has not yet been established. It will include 2-3 day camps as well as week-long day camps. Camps will run from 9:00 a.m.–12:00 p.m., 1:00–4:00 p.m., and 9:00 a.m.–4:00 p.m. Camps will also require 1 – 1.5 hours of set-up and clean-up each day.
- We prefer you assist with or lead at least one entire summer camp program.

### Training:

- Trainings will be offered at the beginning of the summer, and will be specific for each camp. Training requirements will vary for each camp, but could be up to two days, 8 hours per day.

### Requirements and Experience Necessary:

- No experience necessary! You will be provided with all the training you need.
- No criminal record. Background checks will be completed and references will be checked.
- Must be able to work outside in hot weather for long periods of time and not mind getting wet and dirty.
- Good communication skills as well as experience with youth, education, or environmental topics a plus.
- Must be at least 14 years old. Teens in 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade can apply to be 4-H Teen Camp Counselors.
