Youth Education Programs

Responsibilities:

- Assist with monthly youth education programs and activities
- Help with set-up and clean-up

Time Commitment:

- Monthly programs vary in time requirements, but usually take place from 6-8 p.m. on weeknights or during the hours of 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. on Saturdays. Plan for an extra hour of helping with set-up and clean-up for all events.
- You can sign up for as many programs as you would like.
- Volunteer requests will be made prior to each program. If your application is on file we will contact you about volunteer opportunities.



Training:

- Trainings will be held either the day of or a day or two before the events. Trainings will typically last between 1 and 2 hours.

Requirements and Experience Necessary:

- No experience necessary! You will be provided with all the training you need.
- No criminal record.
- Good communication skills as well as experience with youth, education, science, or environmental topics a plus.
- Must be at least 13 years old.
